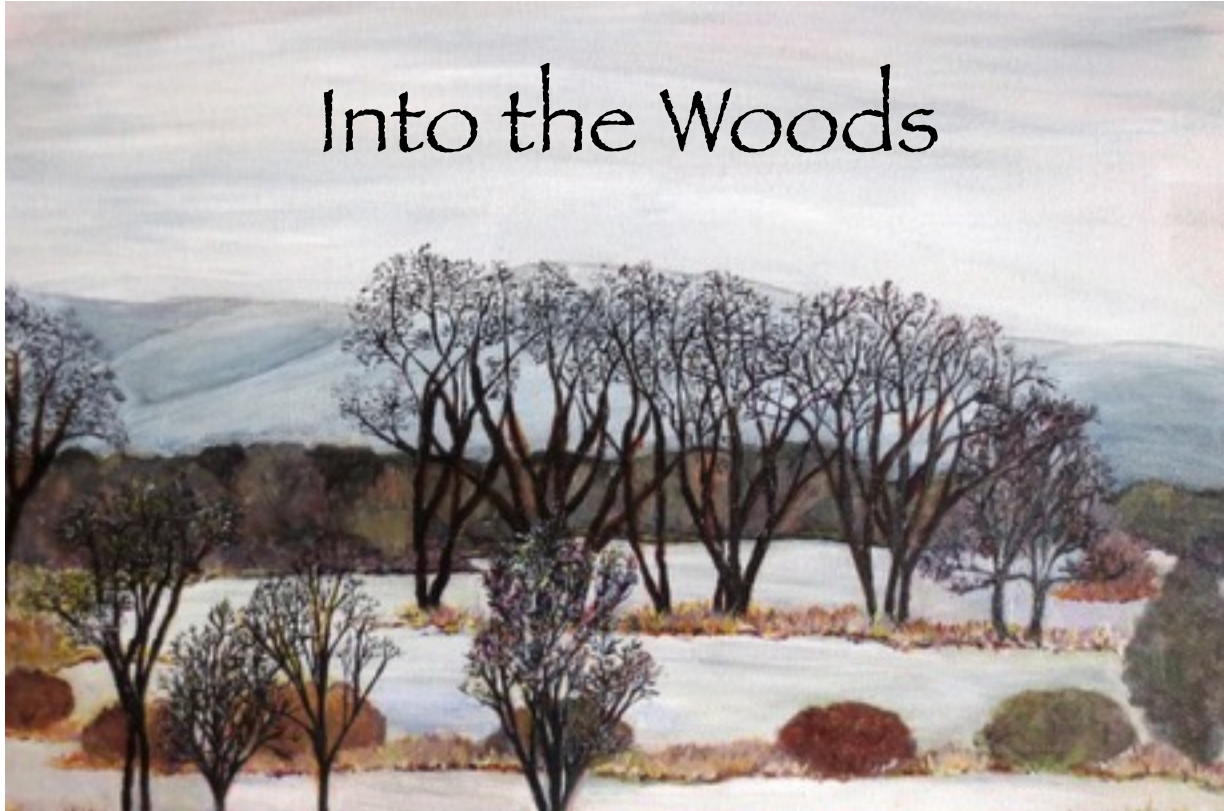

**Theme:**

Our trees and forests have a direct impact on the environment and climate. This exhibit depicts the ecological importance of woodlands, including trees and other flora, fauna, and fungi, as well as ecosystem processes and conservation.

## **Call for Entries:**

This Guild of Natural Science Illustrators exhibit is open to all GNSI-NE Members and any GNSI member who resides in New England - Massachusetts, Rhode Island, Connecticut, Vermont, New Hampshire, Maine and New York (close enough!) in good standing (membership dues for 2019 paid). Members may submit one or two illustrations. Any traditional media or digital illustrations are welcome. The works do not have to be strictly scientific in nature; they can be more fine art if you desire, as long as they feature the *ecological importance of species* chosen for the theme.

## **Important dates:**

- Exhibit entry forms due on or before: Friday, August 2nd
- Delivery of artwork: If shipping, your artwork must arrive between September 1-10 to Wendy Berube (address below). GNSI-NE will also collect artwork at the Sept 14<sup>th</sup> meeting or at other prearranged times.
- Exhibit hanging date: Tuesday, October 1st
- Exhibit opening reception and artist demonstrations: Wednesday, Oct 9th 6-8pm
- Exhibit take down date: Wednesday, October 30th.

## **Gallery Requirements:**

- All artwork displayed must be your original work and not previously shown at the Mass Migrations exhibit.
- Artists must be members of Mass Audubon.
- Artwork to be displayed cannot be smaller than 8" x 10" or larger than 24" x 24'.
- All artwork must be framed or matted (with a sturdy backing). All framed pieces MUST have a hanging wire, NO sawtooth hangers.
- Habitat will receive a 25% commission on all art sales. Please make checks payable to Mass Audubon Habitat. ALL artwork must be for sale.
- Prices will be displayed on a price list kept at the entry table.
- No artwork may be removed before the end of the show.

## **Liability Statement**

GNSI-NE and the Habitat Education Center and Wildlife Sanctuary are unable to assume liability during the show. Artists exhibit at their own risk. All artwork will be handled with the utmost care.
